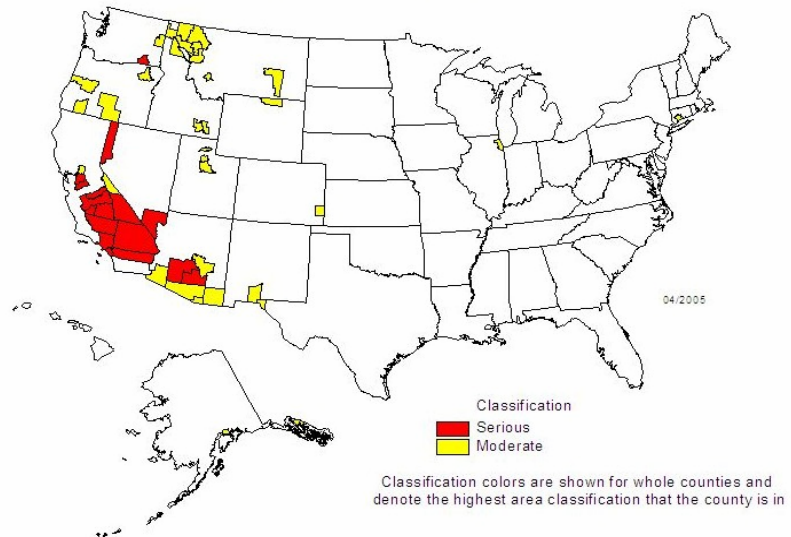
AIR QUALITY NONATTAINMENT AREAS

FOR OZONE AND PM₁₀

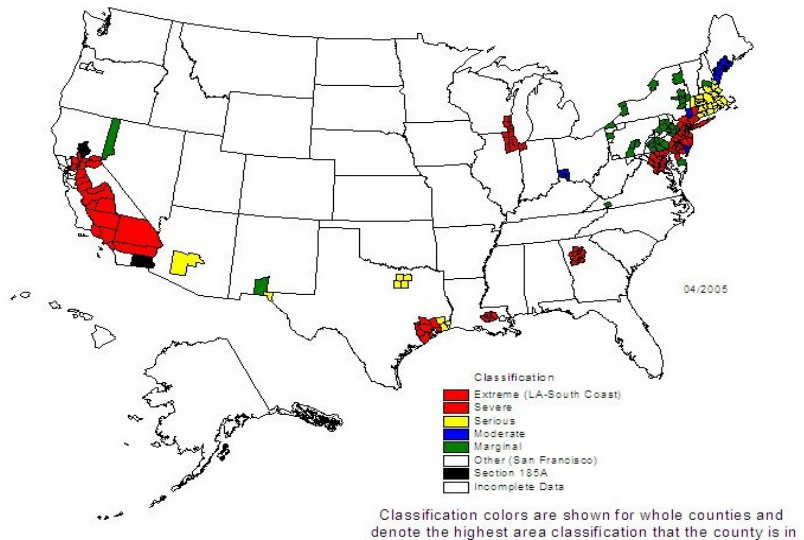
FACT SHEET

An area that is not in compliance with a particular National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) is designated as "nonattainment" for that NAAQS. For example, Fresno County, CA in the San Joaquin Valley, is a nonattainment area for PM₁₀, as well as other NAAQS (see figure below). A total of 55 counties in the United States are designated as "nonattainment" for PM₁₀. In Texas, only El Paso County is classified as nonattainment for PM₁₀. Several Texas counties in the El Paso, Dallas/Ft. Worth, Houston, and Beaumont/Port Arthur areas are classified as nonattainment for ozone.
